Foundational Triads

- **The Identity Triad**

 - Joan's chart is ruled by Jupiter, the planet of faith, expansion, and higher meaning, as it governs her Sagittarius Ascendant.

Tight Natal Aspects

Aspects are the energetic conversations between planets in your chart at birth. They reveal your core strengths, inner tensions, and pathways for growth. Tight aspects (under 2-3° orb) are particularly potent, like energetic hotspots you feel consistently.

- Applying aspects (A) represent energies still building, shaping current life with momentum or pressure to evolve.

Main Aspects:

- **Sun Trine Jupiter | Orb: 1°54' | (A)**
 - A river of grace flowed through her. This aspect blessed her with profound optimism, divine protection (for a time), and an innate belief in the righteousness of her mission. It gave her the charisma and luck to rally armies and crown a king.



Phase 2: Dynamic Interplay – Activations, Tensions & Growth

Objective: Here, we observe how the natal promise was tested and forged in the crucible of time. The planetary transits at the end of her life reveal the cosmic pressures that precipitated her martyrdom and sealed her legacy.

Signature Aspect Analysis

- The **Jupiter-Saturn opposition** forms the spine of Joan's story. Jupiter in Libra in the 10th House is the call to enact divine justice in the public sphere, to be a symbol of hope and balance for a broken nation. But opposite it, Saturn in Taurus in the 5th House demands a heavy, earthly price. It represents the entrenched powers, the unyielding structures, and the personal, creative life force that must be sacrificed (5th House) for the sake of her public role (10th House). This was her destiny: to bring a vision of divine order into a world that would ultimately crush it with its own rigid laws.

Transit Overview & Analysis

Transits are the movements of current planets activating the birth chart. At the moment of his release, the cosmos told a story of profound rebirth.

- **Uranus Transits:** Bring sudden changes, liberation, awakenings, and disruption of the status quo, often heralding innovation.
- **Neptune Transits:** Dissolve old forms, heighten sensitivity, inspire idealism, and can bring spiritualization, confusion, or the uncovering of dreams.
- **Pluto Transits:** Trigger deep transformation, power dynamics, elimination of the outworn, crises leading to regeneration, and profound healing.

Outer Planet Positions at time of death: May 30, 1431:

At 19, Joan was undergoing a profound series of transits that sealed her fate and transformed her from a soldier into a martyr.

- **Transiting Pluto Conjunct Natal Moon (and Natal Pluto)**
 - This is an overwhelmingly powerful transit of fate and transformation. Transiting Pluto at ~20° Gemini was exactly conjunct her natal Moon at 20° Gemini. The Moon represents her physical body and emotional self. Pluto's conjunction signifies a total annihilation and rebirth. - **Transiting Neptune Square Natal Jupiter**

- Transiting Neptune at ~10° Cancer was squaring her natal Jupiter at 12° Libra. This transit dissolves faith, brings confusion, and can manifest as betrayal from those idealized. The divine favor she had so powerfully channeled (Jupiter) was being clouded by deception and disillusionment, leading to a sense of spiritual martyrdom where her grand vision met a watery, tragic end.

At the time of her death, transiting Saturn was at ~23° Sagittarius, conjunct her natal Mercury (22° Sagittarius) and squaring her natal Mars (8° Virgo) and North Node (7° Pisces). This transit manifested as the formal trial and judgment (Saturn) against her words and beliefs (Mercury).
